DUE DILIGENCE PROCESS


We have performed due diligence by leveraging the CFSI/EICC tools and templates with our supply chain partners to obtain information and trace the materials used in their products.

SUMMARY RESULTS

From the information gathered on this initiative we have developed a comprehensive report; based on which we confirm and declare the following:

- We do not have any direct relationship with mining companies
- We have obtained statements and information from suppliers, in the CFSI/EICC template, providing a reasonable level of assurance that the products supplied to DDN are 'conflict free'
- We have reviewed the suppliers who are still going through the process of due diligence and have categorized them as "CM Not Determinable"
- Overall as a corporation, we validate as being 'Conflict Free'.
