As this is DDN's first year driving our environmental initiatives, we do not have a comparable data analysis but our progress during the second half of the year is highlighted below.

Waste Management


- Developed and implemented Waste Management and Recycling system/process in our Chatsworth, California factory which includes:
 - Shredding and recycling waste materials, paper
 - Vendor picks up electrical materials for recycling per R2/ISO14001 standards
 - Wooden pallets - 724
 - Cardboard Packaging - 35,610 lbs.
 - Styrofoam – 11,040 cu.feet.
- Obtain certificates from vendors for all waste management materials

Energy Conservation

- New Economizers installed our Santa Clara, California, Colorado Springs, Colorado, and Columbia, Maryland offices and technology centers.
